

The Divinity of the Word

In Genesis 3:1-7 the serpent introduced **doubt** into Eve's mind about the truth in **God's word**. He then lied to Eve, directly contradicting what God said about eating the forbidden fruit, saying she would *not* die. Adhering to the serpent's lie rather than God's word, Eve and Adam did die just as Father said after partaking of this fruit. It was both a spiritual (separation from Him) and physical death. There are 30 verses of scripture below - in 12 subject groups that address the **value, divinity** and **truth** in God's precious **word**, both that of the Son *and* the Father, as they are one.

1. Matt. 4:4 "It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."
John 8:47 "He that is of God heareth God's words."
John 14:10 "The words that I speak unto I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me."
2. John 14:23-24 "If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with the him. He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings."
John 12:48 "He that rejected me, and received not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day."
3. Psalm 138:2 "I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name."
4. Prov. 7:1 "My son, keep my words, and lay up my commandments with thee."
Psm. 12:6-7 "The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O Lord, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever."
Psm. 119:140 "Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it."
5. John 15:3 "Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you."
John 17:17 "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."
Psm. 96:13 ". . . he shall judge the world . . . the people with his truth."
John 15:7 "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."
6. Matt. 24:35 "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."
7. Isa. 40:8 "The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever."
8. Deut. 4:2 "Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you."
Prov. 30:6 "Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar."
Jer. 23:28 ". . . he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully."
Jer. 26:2 "Thus saith the Lord; Stand in the court of the Lord's house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to worship in the Lord's house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them; diminish not a word:"
Rev. 22:18-19 "For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book; And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book."
9. John 10:35 "If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;"
Luke 24:44 "These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me."
10. Mark 8:38 "Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."
Prov. 7:5 "That they may keep these from the strange woman, from the stranger which flattereth with her words."
11. Amos 8:11 "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD."
12. Prov. 25:2 "It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter."
